You don't have to examine it too closely every time you're out in the park, or clearing their litter tray, just keep checking the general appearance of your dog or cat's faeces against this handy 'Poop Points' scale from day to day, week to week...

How does your dog or cat's poop score today?



Hard, dry and crumbly appearance. Bullet-like (kickable). **Points**

Dry, but well-formed appearance. (Leaves no mark when picked up).

Points

Well-formed, slightly moist, sticky surface. (Leaves no mark when picked up).

Points

Wet appearance, but still has shape. (Leaves definite marks when picked up).

Points

Soft, shapeless appearance. Mushy, sloppy consistency.

Points

Watery appearance with no shape. Diarrhoea.

Check your dog or cat's digestive health with our Poop Points:

1-2 Points?

A low or slightly low score on the scale means your dog or cat's digestive health may not be at its best. They may be constipated or just slightly dehydrated.

3-4 Points?

A middle score on the Poop Points scale means your dog or cat's digestive health is pretty normal.

5-6 Points?

A high or slightly high score on the scale means your dog or cat may have diarrhoea, which could be caused by an underlying digestive health issue.
